Mr. B.K., who is 52 years old and from Chitwan district, is currently in Chitwan prison for a murder charge. He has been in prison for 2 years, and there's no decision yet about when he will be released. He learned about the SPC program through a notice posted in the prison by Prison Fellowship Nepal. He said, "The staff from Prison Fellowship and a caseworker talked to the prison authorities to find prisoners who needed help for this program. The prison authorities chose some prisoners' children based on the organization's rules. I was happy when I found out that my children were also picked for this help. I filled out the forms for the sponsorship program, and the prison gave me a letter of recommendation. After a few months, the prison authorities told me that my children were chosen for the sponsorship. The staff told me that the organization would help with safety, food, and school fees for my kids. My wife lives in Chitwan district and works as a farmer, but she doesn't earn much. This sponsorship program has really helped my kids with their education, food, and safety."

Additionally, their home was in poor condition, but they lacked the funds for repairs. When our organization learned of their plight, we decided to step in and support them with the construction of a new home. The B.K. family was overjoyed and deeply grateful upon hearing this wonderful news.

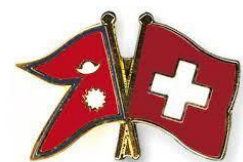

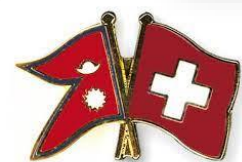
